## PROGRAM:

The Summer Learning Hub is an extension of the school year and will include engaging lessons and activities in math, language arts, social studies and science. The focus will be on both the academic and total well-being aspects to foster continuous growth and success of every child.

- Specials classes that align to the Nā Hopena A'o (HĀ) framework will be offered to all students. Our HĀ team will provide classes in: Basic Hawaiian Language, Hawaiian Studies, Mindfulness, Social Emotional Well-Being, 'Aina, Ukulele and Physical Fitness.
- Weekly field trips will reinforce HĀ initiatives as we visit local sites to learn about stewardship and kuleana in our community.



## REGISTRATION:

Open to students who finished the SY in grades K-5 and HLIP Papa M-2. Applications are at the office and are due back by May 20, 2022

**Participation is MANDATORY for students with excessive absences (25+ days total for the SY) or Tardies (20+ days total for the SY) and students who are below the grade level proficiency (WB or DP) in one of more of the core content areas.**
